At a recent Meetup of the Instructional Design and eLearning group, we gave a presentation on:


xAPI: How it's being used to capture online and offline learning experiences




Participant Demographics

Understanding of xAPI and it's potential


Next we asked participants:


· how much they already know about xAPI


 whether they see any potential for using xAPI in their organisation

It's clear from the results that the industry view of xAPI is that it has great potential to improve and track learning experiences, as well as supporting new types of learning experiences, and delivering learning experiences outside an LMS.









Designing learning around xAPI

xAPI changes the way we capture data, but it also **changes the amount of data captured and the impact of this on learners**. With this in mind, we asked participants:

- if they already consider the type and amount of data they want to capture when they are designing learning
- the types of learning data they want to be able to report on
- how learners might react to this kind of data capture, and any potential privacy concerns.









A Learning Ecosystem


Finally, we asked participants about the future of xAPI and the learning ecosystem, including:
